Every child deserves access to a active, involved, loving father. No child deserves to experience the pain of not knowing who his father is or when she might see him again.

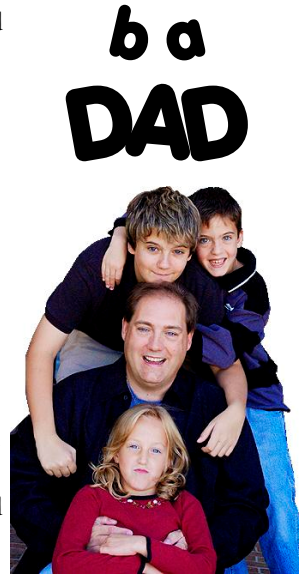
Dads who work at improving their ability to understand, provide, and care for their children need tools for accomplishing this vital task.

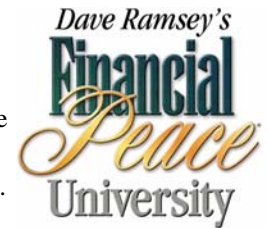
